

Facility Guidelines for Arenas that are being used by North Toronto Hockey Association for Select Tryouts. If there are any changes a message will be sent to all coaches.

North Toronto Arena Protocols

- Maximum number of skaters on the ice is 40.
- The arena would like all players and team officials born in 2009 and older to be fully vaccinated to enter the Arena.
- For those not already vaccinated, those born in 2009 and older will need to have their second shot by October 17th to be fully vaccinated by November 1st.
- Only players and coaches are allowed in the arena for tryouts.
- No spectators or parents will be allowed to enter the arena. Team officials are to help with anyone who can not tighten their skates.
- Before coming to the Arena all players must complete a COVID screening on the day of tryout. Please ensure parents bring a printed copy to the arena. Here is the link to the COVID Screening.
- All skaters must remain in the dressing room until it is time to go on the ice.
- There is no warm up of any kind allowed anywhere in the arena. If needed this should be done outside before they come inside.
- All Tryouts will get a flood before they go on. NO EXCEPTIONS.
- Team Officials can come in 20 minutes before their ice time to set up a table just inside the sliding doors or if it is nice outside the registration can be done outside.
- All players will enter the arena at the same time and will be let in 15 minutes before the tryout starts to check in and go to their dressing room.
- Each team will be given 3 Dressing Rooms. Maximum of 7 individuals per dressing room. There will be 2 additional chairs in the hallway. If any team thinks that they will have more than 23 SKATERS they must call the Arena to try and make arrangements.
- No showers will be available
- Team Officials who are not going on the ice will stay in the PENALTY BOX AREA DURING THE TRYOUT.
- Once all players are in the arena the front doors will be locked.
- All players are encouraged to come dressed for tryouts except for skates.
- Face masks must always be worn in the Arena; they can be removed once you put on your Helmet. When you come off the ice and you remove your Helmet you must put your Face Mask back on.
- No outside food or drinks allowed into the arena
- At ALL times within the facility please adhere to social distancing requirements (6'/2m apart)
- Physical distancing on the ice is mandatory. No close contact, body-checking, face-offs, or spitting.
- If you need to use the washroom, please use the main arena washrooms.
- Players and Team Officials are to be out of the arena 15 minutes after they come off the ice.
- There are no meetings allowed with players or team officials anywhere in the Arena.
- The Pro Shop is open if anyone needs a Sharp or anything else.
- It is the responsibility of the team rep or coach to make sure that all participants are aware of the protocols and to keep a list of all participants for each tryout.

As of September 22, 2021 Proof of vaccination and personal identification (e.g. driver's license, birth certificate, utility bill, etc.) is required for participants, visitors and spectators entering indoor arenas.

All parents, spectators and players must complete a COVID Health Screening. Parents can use the following City of Toronto Link

All other public health measures must be followed such as:

- **Masking** You must wear a mask at all times when you are in the arena except for when players and team officials are on the ice.
- **Physical distancing** -At ALL times within the facility please adhere to social distancing requirements (6'/2m apart)
- Capacity restrictions will be at 50% capacity for all City of Toronto Rinks. Capacity information should be posted.
- Dressing rooms will be open but please abide by each arena's rules for capacity.

COVID-19 Measures

- As per the Province of Ontario vaccination policy, proof of vaccination is required for all players, team officials and parents born in 2009 and older..
- Before coming to the arena all players, coaches, spectators and parents must complete a COVID screening. Parents can use the following <u>City of Toronto Link</u>
- For players, please complete and print the following COVID screening
- 1 parent is allowed in the arena per player.
- Scrimmages and game-play are allowed.
- Dressing rooms are available 30 minutes prior to and after the rental. Showers are unavailable at this time.
- When you are not on the ice, face masks or coverings are mandatory at all times.
- Facility staff will direct players to designated dressing rooms that follow the 2m/6ft distancing rules.
- You must stay in the dressing rooms or assigned area until the ice surface is ready for use.
- No off-ice or pre/post skate warm-ups are allowed.
- Player benches/penalty boxes must be following 2m/6ft-distancing rules.



RINX

- Group size will be limited to 30 people total, this includes players, parents, spectators and coaches. If the group exceeds the 30 person limit, RINX staff will ask the organizer to select people to leave the facility.
- Proof of vaccination is required for all players, team officials and parents born in 2009 and older. As per the Province of Ontario vaccination policy.
- Before coming to the arena all players, coaches, spectators and parents must complete a COVID screening. For players you can use the paper form <u>COVID Screening.</u> For parents use this link -<u>City of Toronto Link.</u>
- We recommend that players get dressed at home as much as possible but dressing rooms will be available. There will also be chairs placed 6'/2m apart outside of the dressing rooms for putting on skates to help maintain social distancing.
- For RINK 1/4 Please ENTER from 65 Orfus Road main entrance and EXIT from the same doors adhering to the directional arrows on the floors.
- **For RINK 2/3** Please ENTER from 67 Dufflaw Road main entrance and EXIT from the same doors adhering to the directional arrows on the floors.
- A face mask must be worn at all times inside of the facility, except for when on the ice surface
- You are only permitted to arrive 15 minutes before the start time of your rental and you must vacate within 15 minutes of your rental ending.
- At ALL times within the facility please adhere to social distancing requirements (6'/2m apart)
